- Introduction to Ultrasound in Hand Surgery
 - The role of ultrasound in hand and wrist diagnosis & intervention
 - · Optimising machine settings.
 - Selecting the right transducers and positioning for optimal imaging
- Hand & Wrist Anatomy Under Ultrasound
 - **US to define anatomy-** identify nerves and tendons; follow structures; observe structures moving
 - **US to confirm examination findings** tendon integrity and stability; identify foreign body & position; assess collateral ligament integrity and endpoints; identify solid Vs fluid-filled lesions.
 - **US to enable interventions -** Guided aspiration and injection; nerve blocks.

- Carpal tunnel injection Safe and accurate placement under ultrasound guidance
- Trigger finger injection Identifying the A1 pulley for guided procedures
- CMCJ injection Ensuring accurate targeting of the joint space
